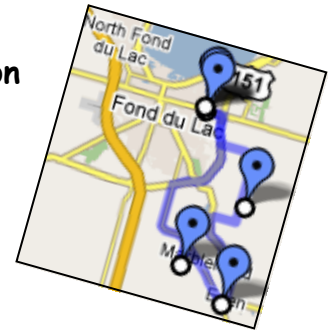

Visited on the Tour:

Vir-Clar Farm: The anaerobic digester at this dairy converts manure from 1300 milking cows into electricity, compost, & animal bedding.

Fuelmakers, LLC: This biomass gasification demonstration plant is turning wood chips & garbage into liquid fuel while researching costs and feasibility for the state.

Nett Land & Development, Inc.: Tour Pheasant Run Subdivision, one of the county's only conservation-design housing developments. With slightly smaller lots & shared open space, the concept offers municipalities & residents more green space.

Horicon Bank: Learn about the newly installed ground-source heat pump (geothermal) system, why the bank chose to install it, & how it operates.
