## Frequently Asked Questions

### What types of courses are offered?

Pre-major courses, general education courses and courses to fulfill an Associate of Arts and Science Degree are offered.

### What computer skills are required?

Students need to be proficient in word processing, e-mail and the internet. A one-credit class, offered each fall, helps students develop the computer skills needed to be successful in an online learning environment.

### Will my credits transfer to another college to complete my bachelor's degree?

Yes! Our courses transfer to the UW four-year campuses as well as many private colleges.

- Submit official transcripts of all previously attended colleges
- Submit an official copy of your high school transcript
- Send your ACT or SAT scores to us if you are under 21
- Apply for financial aid at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) and submit scholarship applications
- Take a placement test in math and English, if needed
- Participate in orientation and registration if needed

## How it Works

- Most classes are taught using an accelerated, blended method that combines traditional in-class time with an online learning component. You cover the same amount of material as a traditional 15 week course, but usually in 7-8 weeks (the course rigor is the same).
- Because of the online learning component, computer literacy is highly recommended.
- Complete four courses per semester taking two classes at a time for a total of twelve credits.
- Complete your associate degree in four regular semesters plus one summer or winterim as a full-time Evening Degree Program student.
